The Arts Foundation of Cape Cod is presenting a free regional art exhibit, "**ROYGBIV, Exploring the Color Spectrum**" at the Cotuit Center for the Arts from January 3 to February 7, 2009. This is the third annual educational exhibit of its kind presented by the Arts Foundation of Cape Cod, and will feature over 50 established Cape Cod artists.

Maggie Van Sciver, President of the Arts Foundation of Cape Cod describes the exhibit. "Keeping younger patrons in mind, art work will be displayed at a height of 4 feet throughout the exhibit – right at children's eye level" she said. In addition, a mini-art library will be made available to visitors, and a series of child-friendly events will be scheduled over the course of the month. School groups will be welcomed to the exhibit for the duration of the show, and will be given docent-led tours and art instruction customized to the age level of the children.

ROYGBIV is presented through the generous support of College PayWay.
