Arts Foundation Of Cape Cod Presents Interactive Art Exhibit, 'First Things First'

The Arts Foundation of Cape Cod will present a free, major regional art exhibit, "First Things First," at the Cotuit Center for the Arts from January 9 through February 6. This is the fourth annual regional exhibit presented by the arts foundation, and will feature more than 50 established Cape Cod artists whose selected works represent those people, places, things or ideas that are most important to them. It is free and open to the public.

Keeping younger patrons in mind, artwork will be displayed at children's eye level; a mini-art library will be made available to visitors, and a series of child-

friendly events will be scheduled over the course of the month. School groups will be given docent-led tours and art instruction customized to the age level of the children attending.
