CAPE COD — The Arts Foundation of Cape Cod will present a free, major regional art exhibit, **FIRST THINGS FIRST**, at the Cotuit Center for the Arts from January 9 to February 6, 2010. This free exhibit is the fourth annual regional exhibit presented by the Arts Foundation of Cape Cod, and will feature over 50 established Cape Cod artists.

Keeping younger patrons in mind, art work will be displayed at a height of 4 feet throughout the exhibit -- right at children's eye level. In addition, a mini-art library will be made available to visitors, and a series of child-friendly events will be scheduled over the course of the month. School groups will be welcomed to the exhibit for free for the duration of the show, and will be given docent-led tours and art instruction customized to the age level of the children.
