on Cape Cod, and contribute positively to the quality of life and economic vitality of the region. Preference is given to specific program initiatives, particularly those enhancing the arts education of learners of all ages, and to collaborative efforts within the arts community.

In the last 12 months, the AFCC has distributed more than \$49,000 in grants to 41 individual artists and cultural organizations on the Cape. Grant funds are made possible by the proceeds of the foundation's annual TD Bank Pops by the Sea concert.
