Of particular local interest is a \$1,000 grant to **Sturgis Library** for a multi-media projector to be shared among the seven village libraries. Tales of Cape Cod, headquartered in Barnstable Village's Olde Colonial Courthouse, will get \$1,500 to digitize its archive of historical interviews with Cape Codders.... More concert news: Cape Cod Melody Tent announced 10 new shows for its summer season including, on July 17, **The Happy Together Tour** featuring The Turtles, The Grass Roots, The Buckingham, Mickey Dolenz of The Monkees and Mark Lindsay of Paul Revere and the Raiders.
