On Tuesdays and Fridays in July and August and Sunday's in August from 6:00PM-7:30PM, all are invited to grab some chairs, a blanket and dancing shoes and enjoy a summer evening on the harbor as the Town of Barnstable's HyArts district and its generous sponsors present FREE concerts at Aselton Park –right on Hyannis harbor at the corner of South and Ocean Street.

On Sundays in July the Barnstable Summer Family Theater presents FREE Shakespeare in the Park performances at Aselton Park beginning at 5:00PM. These multi-talented Barnstable High School students bring new enthusiasm and a fresh look at the Bard's masterpiece of fun and humor and confusion.
